



# ICONIC HOUSES LECTURE: MELNIKOV HOUSE IN VILLA TUGENDHAT

TUESDAY 15 October 2019, 6 p.m.

A lecture by Pavel Kuznetsov, director of the Konstantin and Viktor Melnikov State Museum and deputy director of the Schusev State Museum of Architecture in Moscow, is part of the European Iconic Houses lecture tour, which will visit six European destinations in its fifth year.

Pavel Kuznetsov will present the unique Melnikov House designed by architect Konstantin Melnikov for himself and his family. The house was built between 1927–1929 and was to test Melnikov's concept of housing. The architect believed that the essence of his house lay in balance and equivalence of weight, light, air and heat. The lecture will be accompanied by fragments of the documentary „Konstantin Melnikov“ (1999) by Jeta Christiaans and Marjo Leupers.

The lecture will be simultaneously interpreted from English, the film will be presented in the original version.
